Hello everyone,

As promised during the meeting of the CIJB in Valencia on 07/04/2018, you can find in the annex of this document the renewed regulations. These have been adapted, taking into account these parameters:

- Innovate the different disciplines
- Facilitate the tasks of the referee (s)
- Facilitate the integration of new players, countries, ...
- Fairplay
- Professionalize the image of the CIJB
- Experiences in previous CIJB tournaments
- Contacts with different national players and coaches

At the end of 2020 an evaluation of the regulations will be carried out and, if necessary, we will adapt some things.

Below is a list of rules / procedures, which have nothing to do with the modalities in question. These were approved during the last meeting:

- The members of the Technical Commission: Geert Vandervelden (director), Bianca Van der Veen (director of promotion of the handball for women), Guillaume Dumoulin, Pasqual Sanchis, Paco Casares (referee director) and Adrian Astorga (only member for the world championships).
- The organizing committee will invite the director of the technical committee at least 3 months before the start of the tournament, to control and verify the facilities.
- A team for the European or World Championship will be composed of 11 men and 5 women maximum.
- Female "Single" Wallball Tournament. A maximum of 4 women will be enrolled.
- During the tournaments of the European and world championships, the modality of the organizing country will be included in the program.

Note: The division of points will be decided during the next CIJB meeting.

- During each championship of European and World tournaments, the following disciplines will be mandatory:
  - -Masculine: Llargues, International Game, Wallball (doubles), local discipline.

-Feminine: International Game, Wallball (Double + Individual)

The organizing committee will propose to the director of the Technical Commission the order of the disciplines to be played, which will have to approve it.

- During each tournament of the European Youth Championship, the following disciplines will be played:
- -Boys: Llargues, International Game, Double Wallball (Sub15, Sub17 and Sub19).
- -Girls: International game, Wallball doubles (Sub15, Sub17 y Sub19), more varieties to be chosen by the director of Technical Comission.

The organizing committee will propose to the director of the Technical Commission the order of the disciplines to be played, which will have to approve it.

The heads of series for the European and World Championships will be determined taking into account, respectively, the results of the last European or World Championship. The vote during the meeting of 04/07/2018 was: 4 votes in favor: 2 against and 1 abstention. The Director of the Technical Committee will determine the heads of the series taking into account the previous decision and with the organizing country, in a draw in which the groups will be configured and that will be broadcast in live.

- At the end of the tournament, the tournament director will ask all national coaches to fill out a document to determine which are the best players.

For the following players prizes will be awarded:

- Best male player (+21 years old)
- Best female player (+21 years old)
- Best young player (under 21)
- Best young player (under 21)

Coaches can not give points to their own players. The distribution of the points will be: 1  $^{\circ}$  = 4 points; 2  $^{\circ}$  = 2 points and 3  $^{\circ}$  = 1 point.

The Tournament Director will present the results to the President of the CIJB.

- -The deadline for sending the tournament registration MUST be respected and this is to give the organizing country the opportunity to organize everything perfectly.
- At least 1 month before the start of the tournament, each interested country sends the names and personal numbers of the players to the organizing committee, this with a copy of their passport. Players who have dual citizenship must prove it with an official document (embassy, etc.,).

The organizing committee sends the names of all the players to the director of the Technical Committee, who will make it available to the responsible referee CIJB.

-The profile of the tournament director has been approved and taken into account with the experiences of the previous tournaments, he will be the manager during the CIJB

tournaments. At each venue, you will be assisted by an organizing committee and / or a manager (s).

Note: It must be compensated for his travel, hotel and food expenses.

- For the 2020 World Championship in Belgium, a new ball must be found for the international game. The Technical Commission is taking care of this and will make all the countries, members of the CIJB, aware of the new ball so that these countries know where to buy it and could prove it.
- For the international game to have another image, we must find another name for this game. Ideas are welcome and can be sent to the director of the Technical Commission.
